- While we are fortunate to have arrangements in place for bussing our students to these great learning opportunities, you may have plans that require you to transport your child separately. In order to do this, please ensure that you have notified your student's teacher prior to the day of the trip in order to make these arrangements. If these arrangements include transportation with an adult other than the student's parent, then the school will need to be provided with a copy of the driver's insurance and current criminal record check.
- Although these trips are taking place off-site, please know that our regular school expectations are still in place. This includes our dress code, our expectations for student behaviour, and our rules around student cell phone usage.
- Lastly, please ensure that students are prepared for a big day on these trips. Packing healthy lunches and snacks, as well as plenty of water are essentail to keeping kids going on these action-packed days. The Alberta weather can also change quickly at this time of year, so please ensure students come prepared (dressed in layers and with appropriate footwear for walking).

We look forward to these exciting school activities and hope your students will get the most out of them. Should you have any questions please don't hesitate to contact your child's teacher for more information.
















