Parent Council Update


Hello DMS Parents,

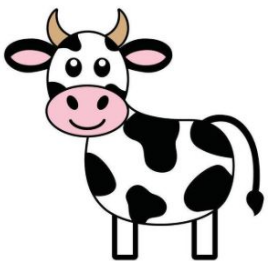


Constable Gargallo stopped by to play basketball with a group of our students! So Fun!
