Traffic Safety

We revisit traffic safety in classes to discuss specific issues related to arriving at and exiting our school grounds safely and we appreciate it if parents/guardians can review road safety with their students at this time of year as well. We have had a few issues lately and a few close calls so it is important that everyone play a part to keep our kids safe. Any way that we can partner to keep our kids safe is a win!

Some specific issues that you could review:

- Using the marked crosswalks instead of crossing in the middle of the streets (especially during the busy drop-off and pick-up times).
- Not walking out from between the buses when parked in our bus loop (walking around and using the crosswalks is the safest).
- Walking bikes/scooters/skateboards to the bike racks instead of weaving through student traffic during the busy morning and after school timeframes.



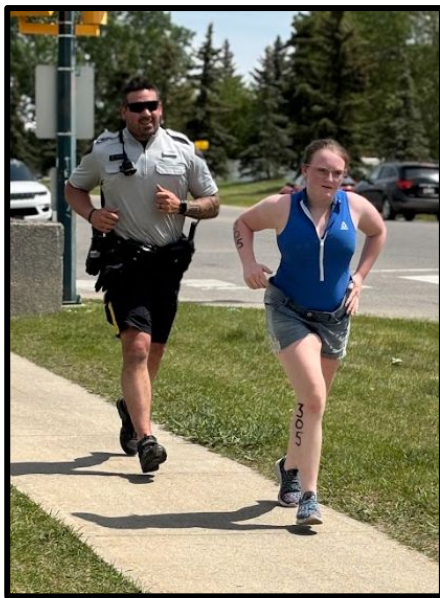

Parent Council Update


Hello DMS Parents,
