Traffic Safety

With the spring/summer weather setting in it is great to see many students now able to travel to and from school on foot or with their own set of wheels. We revisit traffic safety in classes to discuss specific issues related to arriving at and exiting our school grounds safely and we appreciate it if parents/guardians can review road safety with their students at this time of year as well. We have had a few issues lately and a few close calls so it is important that everyone play a part to keep our kids safe. Any way that we can partner to keep our kids safe is a win!

Some specific issues that you could review:

- Using the marked crosswalks instead of crossing in the middle of the streets (especially during the busy drop-off and pick-up times).
- Not walking out from between the buses when parked in our bus loop (walking around and using the crosswalks is the safest).
- Walking bikes/scooters/skateboards to the bike racks instead of weaving through student traffic during the busy morning and after school timeframes.
